

RECESS MEETING OF APRIL 16, 2013

Be it remembered that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Ocean Springs met in a Recess Meeting at City Hall in the City of Ocean Springs at 6:00 p.m. on April 16, 2013. Mayor Moran presiding, Aldermen Cox, Gill, McDonnell, Cody, Dalgo and Hagan were present. Also present was City Clerk Shelly Ferguson and City Attorney John Edwards. Alderman Denyer was absent.

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

Alderman Cody gave the invocation and the Mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PROCLAMATIONS

The Mayor read a proclamation declaring the week of May 19-25, 2013 as National Public Works Week.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

None.

CONSENT AGENDA

Motion was made by Alderman Hagan, seconded by Alderman Dalgo and unanimously carried to approve the Consent Agenda.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Peer Review Committee:

Motion was made by Alderman Hagan, seconded by Alderman Cody and unanimously carried to approve the purchase of a 2013 Chevrolet Silverado truck for the water and sewer department to replace the vehicle totaled in an accident on April 9, 2013, to be purchased from Preston Hood Chevrolet in the amount of \$19,288.20 and authorize allocating the insurance deductible for document restoration in the amount of \$5,000.00 and begin the restoration process caused by the fire in the Civil Service trailer on April 8, 2013, Peer Review Committee concurs (Exhibit 7-a).

Motion was made by Alderman Gill, seconded by Alderman Dalgo and unanimously carried to authorize All South Engineering, Inc. to proceed with the design phase for the

north side of the Government Street Sidewalk Improvements Project, the Peer Review Committee concurs.

CONSENT AGENDA

Motion was made by Alderman Dalgo, seconded by Alderman Hagan and unanimously carried to readdress the Consent Agenda to pull item (6-o).

Motion was made by Alderman Dalgo, seconded by Alderman Hagan and unanimously carried to authorize the Mayor to execute the Construction Engineering & Inspection (CE&I) contract with Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. (BKI) related to the STP project for Government Street Improvements Project, pending MDOT concurrence. Alderman Cody abstained from the vote (Exhibit 6-o).

ALDERMEN'S FORUM

Motion was made by Alderman Hagan, seconded by Alderman Gill and unanimously carried to adopt the Resolution of the City of Ocean Springs, Mississippi to temporarily allow consumption of beverages and sale of beer on public property for Mayfest, 2013 (Exhibit 8-a).

The Mayor stated she is scheduling a meeting on Monday with the downtown merchants, restaurant owners and lounge owners to ask them to consider contributing to the cost the City incurs with the special events such as Mayfest.

Motion was made by Alderman Dalgo, seconded by Alderman Cox to appoint Stephanie Lee to the Historic Preservation Commission.

Alderman Cody asked the Police Department to check a dog problem on Teringo Circle.

Alderman McDonnell asked for a status update on the kudzu lot on Magnolia Avenue. The City Engineer stated there is a problem with clearing the title to the property.

Alderman McDonnell asked for the original list of projects to be accomplished with the BP settlement funds to determine if any of these projects would qualify for the Restore Act funding. The Mayor will provide this list before the next board meeting.

Alderman McDonnell asked if the City has spent more than \$23,000.00 on the proposed hotel project located on Government Street. The Mayor reported the City spent \$23,000 that was paid by the developer on water and sewer upgrades. She also stated there was slip lining work done for the benefit of the entire block. There was Corps of Engineers funding along with CDBG Streetscape grant funding spent on these upgrades.

The Mayor stated she asked the Public Works Director for a breakdown of all expenses; which grants covered these expenses and if any expenses were paid from the general fund. The City Engineer reported the expenses incurred to pave the alley and drainage in the alley came from CDBG Streetscape grant. The Public Works Director stated there were some costs incurred by his department that was not reimbursed by the developer or grants. Alderman McDonnell asked that any additional expenses be identified to the Board related to the Fallo property.

Motion was made by Alderman Dalgo, seconded by Alderman Cody and unanimously carried to authorize up to \$360.00 from Ward 4 Capital Improvement Account to advertise the City's resources at the Tastes of Ocean Springs event.

Alderman Cox asked the Board to consider not donating to all of the special interest groups.

The Mayor announced Ocean Springs was recognized as one of the three communities chosen for as the 2013 Great American Main Street Award.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Motion was made by Alderman Cody, seconded by Alderman Gill and unanimously carried to go into closed session to determine the necessity of going into executive session.

The City Clerk returned to the meeting and announced a motion was made by Alderman Cody, seconded by Alderman Cox and unanimously carried to remain in executive session to discuss potential land acquisition and potential litigation in the Fire Department.

Motion was made by Alderman Dalgo, seconded by Alderman Hagan and unanimously carried to discuss potential litigation in Ward 5 in Executive Session.

Motion was made by Alderman Cody, seconded by Alderman Hagan and unanimously carried to return to regular session.

Motion was made by Alderman Hagan, seconded by Alderman Cody and unanimously carried to adjourn until 6:00 p.m. on May 7, 2013.
