

SPECIAL CALL MEETING OCTOBER 4, 2013

Be it remembered that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Ocean Springs met in a Special Call meeting at the Ocean Springs City Hall in the City of Ocean Springs at 10:00 a.m. on October 4, 2013. *Mayor Pro Tem* Cody presiding, Aldermen Cox, Gill, Denyer and Impey were present. Also present was City Clerk Shelly Ferguson. The Mayor and Aldermen McDonnell and Dalgo were absent.

The *Mayor Pro Tem* called the meeting to order.

The Special Call Meeting is for the purpose of any and all matters pertaining to any and all issues related to Tropical Storm/Hurricane Karen.

The E.O.C. Director, Nate Wilson, gave an update on Tropical Storm Karen. He recommended declaring a State of Emergency for the City of Ocean Springs but will not be activating the E.O.C. at this time. He stated the County is not opening any shelters and no evacuations have been issued. He also recommended the City should follow the lead of the County pertaining to shelters and evacuation.

Motion was made by Alderman Cox, seconded by Alderman Denyer and unanimously carried to adopt the Proclamation of Existence of a Local Emergency by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Ocean Springs Mississippi concerning Tropical Storm/Hurricane Karen.

Motion was made by Alderman Cox, seconded by Alderman Gill and unanimously carried to appoint David Wicker as the Deputy E.O.C. Director.

Motion was made by Alderman Impey, seconded by Alderman Denyer and unanimously carried to adjourn the Special Call Meeting.
